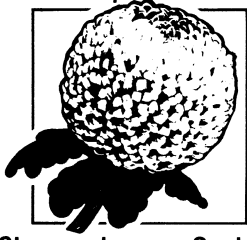

THE SOCIETY'S SHOW RULES

1. All Exhibits are to be in accordance with the NCS, NDS, RHS, NVS & NGS Classification. Judging will be conducted under the appropriate current Code of Rules.
2. The decision of the Judges shall be final, and they are hereby empowered to withhold or diminish any prize if they consider the Exhibit to be of insufficient merit.
3. All specimens must be grown by, and have been the bone fide property of the Exhibitor, for at least three months previous to the Show.
4. Any person obtaining a prize fraudulently will be liable to forfeit all prizes to which he would otherwise be entitled. Any exchange or lending of exhibits will disqualify both exhibitors.
5. All matters in dispute to be settled by the Committee.
6. Any objection is to be made to the Secretary, in writing, with a deposit of 50p on the first day of the show.
7. Whilst every precaution will be taken by the Committee, they will not hold themselves responsible for the loss of, or damage to any exhibit.
8. No exhibit shall be moved before the end of the show.
9. Naming of blooms compulsory in Chrysanthemum classes. All other exhibits to be named where possible.
10. **Late Show** - An exhibitor shall be considered a novice until he or she has won the appropriate Novice section and/or one 1st prize on any relevant higher section at the appropriate Elsecar Show. The committee reserves the right in special cases to debar any member from showing in the novice classes.
Early Show – An exhibitor shall be considered a novice until he or she has won Class 11, 12 or 24 for the appropriate flower at the Early Show.
11. In Vase for Effect Classes, exhibitors may use their own vases. In all other classes vases provided by the Society MUST be used.
12. Chrysanthemum exhibits to be staged in accordance with NCS rules.
13. Exhibitors will be allowed to place their own blooms on the staging in the hall, but will not be allowed in the Hall during judging.

14. Entries on the prescribed form will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the end of staging time.

15. Prize money must be collected on the day of the show.

16. Floral Art must be arranged in the hall.

Any exhibitor wishing to donate their entries for sale after either of the shows for Society Funds, would they please inform any Committee member.

returned to the Secretary at least a fortnight before the date of the next Show.

In the event of a cup being divided, the winner who takes the same for
the first six months must make arrangements to hand over same to the
other winner for the remaining six months.

Judges Awards

The NCS Silver and Bronze Medals and two NCS Certificates of merit
are all awarded at the discretion of the Judges.

At the Late Show Satin Rosettes will be awarded to all trophy winners, Satin
Rosette will be awarded to the best vase in each section of the show plus £2
Society Award of Merit for Best Large or Medium Exhibition bloom.
